Join well-known artist, Marge Kinney, for an enjoyable, casual, hands-on experience of painting an impressionistic landscape. Use the artist’s materials for your painting on canvas. Take your painting home as a great memory of your visit. This program is perfect for executives, spouses, and guests. Ideally held on hotel grounds or at a facility where tables, chairs, or sunbrellas can be provided.



**Group Size:** Ideal: 10 - 22 people  
Average size: 15 (less is OK too)  
For larger groups contact artist

**Time:** Choice of session/time frame  
Typical class time: two-and-half hours  
Morning: 9:15 – 11:45  
Afternoon: 1:15 – 3:45

**Location:** Outdoors on hotel terraces or lawns,  
in conference rooms with windows,  
in parks over-looking the ocean or along scenic bluff tops, etc.

For each student, Kinney provides a canvas or board, palette, easel (if away from hotel\*) paint, paint napkin, brushes, apron, envelope for carrying finished painting, paint water, pencil and picture card for the art lesson. If the event is planned for guests to be seated, as most are, plastic table covers are provided. No chairs are provided for bluff top classes with easels.

**\*Easels are only used** on bluff tops or off site locations when tables aren’t available. Class is usually limited to 15. When class is larger, tables and chairs are provided by event planner.

Marge Kinney has taught thousands of students. She is an accomplished artist whose work has been licensed worldwide: Pimpernel UK, licensed 12 images for placemats and coasters to sell in 21 countries. She exhibits in many gift stores and art festivals. Her art is used by firms for cards, menus, and displays.
